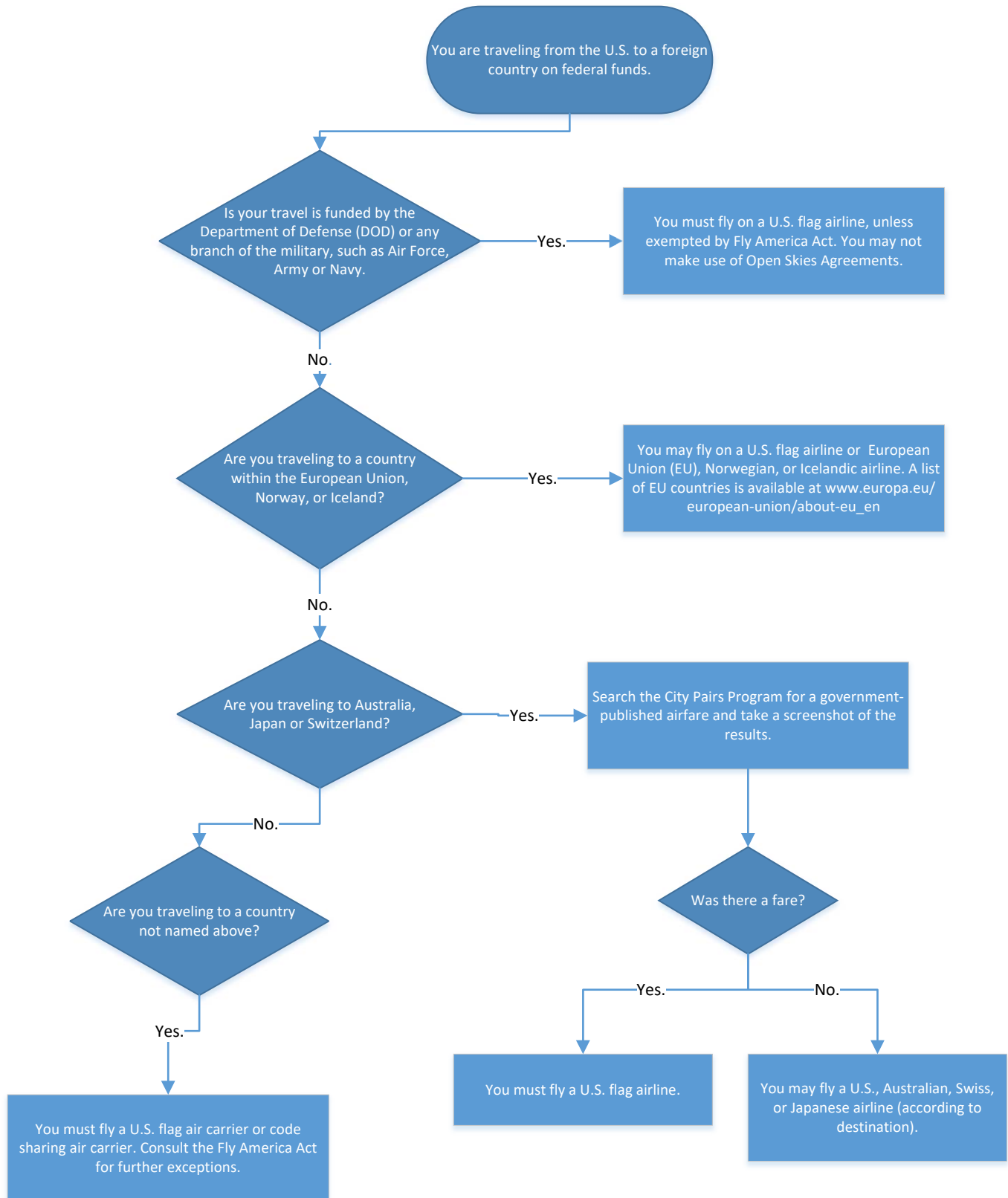


# Fly America, Open Skies Agreements and City Pairs Program

All flights charged to federally-funded projects must comply with the Fly America Act, which requires all travelers to use U.S. flag air carriers or foreign air carriers that code share with a U.S. flag carrier. However, there are exceptions to this requirement, the largest being the Open Skies Agreements that exist with the European Union (plus Norway and Iceland), Australia, Switzerland and Japan. This is a resource for travelers to determine if their flight path is subject to Fly America exceptions.
